Gamma Sigma Delta Research Award

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Evidence of outstanding research activity and productivity, either in fundamental or applied research as evidenced by:
 - Impact of nominee's research
 - > Peer recognition as a research scientist
 - Research contributions as individual, as research leader, or as collaborator
- 2. Membership in Gamma Sigma Delta is required; membership in the Nebraska Chapter is desirable, but not mandatory.
- 3. Persons who have previously received national or international Gamma Sigma Delta research awards are not eligible.
- 4. An award application remains active for three years unless the individual submitting the application asks that it be withdrawn.

FORMAT FOR NOMINATION

- 1. Name of nominee (including an email address)
- 2. Educational background
- 3. Current position
- 4. Description of research responsibilities
- 5. Major research accomplishments; research publications, patents, variety releases and other indices of research productivity.
- 6. National and/or international significance of the nominee's research.
- 7. Three letters of recommendation (including nominator's letter) from persons in a position to evaluate the nominee's research accomplishments.
